GREETING FOR THE 100TH ANNIVERSARY OF THE DFO

Dear DFO members, raptorphiles and friends of falconry, honored guests,

More than 100 years ago, progressive-thinking hunters and ornithologists founded the Deutscher Falkenorden as the first modern falconry association in the world, after falconry had been practically non-existent in Germany for more than 100 years and only lived on in history books.

When an idea persists over four generations, under the most different political and societal conditions, when this idea, its goals and tasks time and again excite people, then this concept must have, as its kernel, a primal meaning, elemental to mankind, reaching far beyond zeitgeist and fashion.

In this context, the twelve DFO state associations will inform the public in presentations regarding the meaning and tasks of falconry, about raptor science, and bird of prey protection during the past 100 years, today and in the future on our celebration day in Berlin.

We also want to celebrate the one hundred years of the revival of falconry in Germany. Because the Corona pandemic did not allow the planned celebration of the 100th foundation day in Berlin, we now hope to come together for a joyous meeting on the occasion of the 100th anniversary of the 1st DFO Meeting on May 26/27, 1923 and celebrate this special occasion of the 100th anniversary of the Association in a fitting manner.

In addition, I welcome you all cordially and wish us all joyful reunion and/or acquaintance on a splendid birthday celebration of our Deutscher Falkenorden!
